Guidelines for the SRTMU Best Campus School Award

1.0

Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University has instituted the SRTMU Best Campus School Award for the best performing School from its main and sub-campuses on its Silver **Jubilee Year** of the establishment. The main objective of instituting this award is to inculcate the best research practices among the faculty members and to motivate them to deliver their best leading to overall academic enrichment of the School in the fields of academic, research, consultancy and extension services.

This document provides the guidelines and proforma for the SRTMU Best Campus School Award.

2.0 **Nature of the Award:**

- 1. One **Best Campus School Award** on annual basis for the best performing School on the main and sub-campuses of the University
- 2. The award consists of a citation (signed by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor) and felicitation of all the teachers from the School
- 3. The awarded School will receive special grant of Rs. 2.00 lakhs from the University fund for up-gradation of existing or securing new facilities for the School

3.0 Purpose: The Best Campus School Award is primarily aimed to achieve following goals

- a. To recognize significant and collective efforts made by the faculty colleagues in enriching the academic, research, consultancy and extension activities undertaken by a School on the main and sub-campuses of the University
- b. This award is also aims to acknowledge the consistently performed efforts in achieving the mandate of the University of towards the Excellence and Equity.
- c. To encourage and build healthy academic competition among the University Schools to deliver their best in the overall development of the University.

4.0 Criteria: The award shall be based on the assessment of the School performance in following aspects:

- 1. Programmes undertaken by the School for the progression of students
- 2. Activities undertaken by the School to promote student success and to enrich the educational experience of students
- 3. Awards, honours, nominations, etc. earned by the School faculty
- 4. Research publications and innovations
- 5. Participation of the faculty in academic programmes like conferences, FDP, etc.
- 6. Patents filed and contributions in technology transfer
- 7. Quality and quantity of research projects undertaken by the School
- 8. Participation of the faculty in national / international projects, activities, etc.
- 9. Organization of national and international conferences, workshops, schools, lecture series, etc
- 10. Contribution of the School and faculty in University administration and development
- 11. The School, once awarded, shall be eligible for re-award after five years

5.0 Selection Committee:

The selection of the **Best Campus School** shall be done by a duly constituted selection committee comprising five senior professors/scientists from different disciplines. At least two members shall be from other Universities or research institute.

6.0 Selection Procedure:

- 1. The selection procedure would be a **two-tier** process: Screening of the applications followed by a brief presentation and discussion (15 minutes). The screening or initial short-listing would be done by the scrutiny election Committee
- 2. The Director of the short listed school shall give a brief presentation before the Selection Committee highlighting specific example(s) of the achievements and efforts made by the School in the areas of teaching-learning, research and development, engagement and collaborations, contributions in University development, and extension services

- 3. The Selection Committee would then recommend name of one of the applicant Schools for conferment of the **Award** by the University
- 4. The name of the **AWARDEE** will be declared and will be awarded in the ceremony announced by the University
- 5. The interested Schools must submit their applications in the prescribed format (Annexure I) to **The Deputy Registrar**, **APDS Section**, **SRTM University**, **Nanded** 431 606
- 6. The award for a particular year may be withheld if no School is found suitable
- 7. The selection committee has right to select/reject/invite applications of from the Schools
- 8. The decision of the University shall be final in all the matters of selection
